Since early 2023, the Sexual Violence Research Initiative (SVRI) and key partners- UN Women, Association for Progressive Communications (APC) and the Global Partnership for Action on Online Gender-Based Harassment and Abuse have been working together and engaging researchers/academics, practitioners, policymakers, and others involved in this field on a process aimed at setting research priorities for the next 5-10 years for fair, effective and relevant research on technology facilitated gender-based violence (TF GBV). TFGBV research is relatively nascent, yet rapidly growing. Collectively set research priorities on TFGBV can influence levels of funding, make sure funding is more strategic and research waste is reduced. A shared research agenda on TFGBV will be a global public good, providing the international community with a set of research questions we can all rally behind.
